‘ACCESS & CARER’S SUITE’ at Thirsk, North Yorkshire



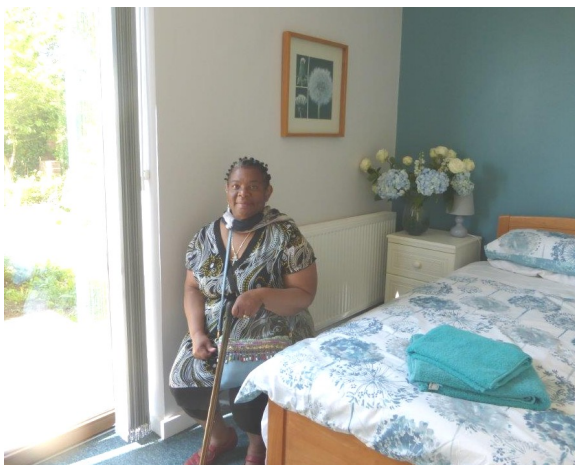
Holy Rood House has been welcoming all kinds of people for all kinds of reasons, from across Britain for almost 25 years.

People of all ages find Holy Rood House is a safe space for when their lives feel unsafe.

Some people come to Holy Rood House for holiday, relaxation or convalescence. Some are carers and need time to re-charge their batteries, and others come for respite and to feel cherished and 'cared for' for a change.

Many of our guests find their way to this safer space at a time of loss, transition, pain and despair.

The residential and wider community of Holy Rood House, offers professional therapeutic and spiritual care within a gentle, and inclusive Christian ethos. All are welcome.



We are pleased to be able to welcome people who live with mobility and/or mental anguish, who require a ground floor room and perhaps wheel-chair access. Our new Access and Carers' Suite also provides an adjoining room for a carer to stay close by.

The adjoining wet room provides not only plenty of space, but also a view of the gardens, so our guests are tempted to venture out to explore and discover the variety of plants and trees and hidden spaces.



The community is pleased that the Access and Carers' Suite is not only wheel-chair friendly but also close to the Chapel, enabling our guests to be able to enjoy the calm and peace there, and also to find their way through the bi-folding doors onto the larger patio, where they are able to sit and enjoy the wonder of all around.

A special addition to this Suite is the provision of double doors leading onto a private patio, looking out over our pond and herb garden, with a gentle ramp taking us directly into the gardens, leading to paths, lawns, orchard, labyrinth and the goats the community keep as pets.
