We will gently explore some of the losses in our lives, using poetry, which has an entire genre devoted to loss and grief: the elegy. We will explore some of elegy's characteristics and look at a number of twentieth and twenty-first-century poems that articulate some of the many nuances and complexities of loss. There will be guided opportunities to write your own poems if you wish, as well as free time, relaxing spaces and home-cooked food.
